I oppose this application due to:

My property backs on to Otokia Creek.

When we purchased our property in 1999 we had researched the area for a safe place to bring up our

children. Our property is in a family trust and we have concerns for the long-term impact on our future

grandchildren and generations to come.

We cycle in the area and enjoy the beauty and peace. Having a landfill in the area will destroy this aspect of recreation for us and our community with the smell, noise from machinery and increase in birds attracted by the landfill.

I am very concerned that the noise and smell of a landfill will spoil what makes Brighton special and the reason it is an area people love to come on sunny days for a swim or for a walk or for holidays. Why would a landfill even be considered in such a beautiful place that is appreciated and enjoyed by so many? We spend a great deal of time outside our house in a covered sheltered area with a beautiful view and this has the potential to be ruined due to the landfill smell and noise.

Our house overlooks Otokia Creek, we have a beautiful view and it is peaceful – a haven. We have enjoyed watching the growing numbers of bird life specifically the White Heron, Falcon, Pied Stilt, Keruru, Piwakawaka, Tui, Pukeko and even Parakeet. The birds that are attracted by landfills put the native birds in the area at risk. People canoe and kayak and raft the creek enjoying the beauty. We watch the creek change depending on the weather and in high rain events we see the increase in run-off from the surrounding hill enter the creek wetlands. A landfill at the head of this catchment area hugely increases the risk of pollution to the water which puts at risk the bird and fish population. I do not understand why the DCC would willingly and knowingly go against the International Civil Aviation Organisation that states a landfill must be no closer than 13kms from any airport. At 4.5 km from the Dunedin International Airport this landfill adds significant risk to flights and may cause delays which, considering there will be new hospital being built in Dunedin requiring input from experts and an increase in specialist consultants, could be cause for concern.

Notes to the submitter

If the application is subject to limited notification, the consent authority may adopt an earlier closing date for submissions once the consent authority receives responses from all affected persons.

You must serve a copy of your submission on the applicant as soon as is reasonably practicable after you have served your submission on the consent authority.

Privacy: Please note that submissions are public. Your name and submission will be included in papers that are available to the media and the public, including publication on the Council website. Your submission will only be used for the purpose of the notified resource consent process

If you are a trade competitor, your right to make a submission may be limited by the trade competition provisions in <u>Part 11A</u> of the Resource Management Act 1991.
