The specific parts of the application/s that my submission relates to are: (Give details)

The Hydrology of the site and the fact that there is not enough edivence to convince me that the Otokia creek will not be affected by having a landfill in the head waters. Also the fact that no or very little notice has been given to the fact that Brighton has grown a lot closer to the site than it was in 1992. There is also a concern that the report is misleading as it states that the Otokia Creek flows to the sea near Brighton when in reallity it flows though the middle of Brighton and across the main swimming

I have lived in Brighton for all my life (45 Years) and have spent a lot of that time playing swimming and floating on or in the Otokia creek. In the last 20 years I have spent time studying the water quality bird life and aquatic habitat in and around the creek. For the last 8 years I have been taking weekly water quality and flow readings at various locations in and around the enitre catchment.

I have walked or kayaked the entire length of the creek and most of the trubitarierys. Over the last 20 years the water quality in the creek has improved due to the septic tanks in Brighton being

replaced with a sewer system. I have also noticed an increase in both bird and aquatic life in the creek and marsh area. The lower Marsh is a reagionally imporant wetland and the home to many birds with several rear visitors (white heron royal spoonbill black stilt to name 3) it is also home to the Red Bullie which is on the endangered list. I feel that this alone is enough to stop the landfill going at Smoothhill. I feel that the normal flow in the creek (it drys up in the upper reachs at times during summer) is not sufficent to dulite any ammount of leachate that enters the creek. This means that a very small quanity of leachate could affect the whole creek from the headwaters to the estuary in the lower reachs. Because of the low flow any containments that enter the estuay will stay for a very long period of time.

You must serve a copy of your submission on the applicant as soon as is reasonably practicable after you have served your submission on the consent authority.

Privacy: Please note that submissions are public. Your name and submission will be included in papers that are available to the media and the public, including publication on the Council website. Your submission will only be used for the purpose of the notified resource consent process
