I live on Taieri Mouth Road, directly between Taieri Mouth and Brighton. We are one house along from Big Stone Road and very much part of a thriving local community all centered around the beach, local waterways and forestry where children and animals are very much central to our lives here. I am making this submission after listening to our community and reading available documentation surrounding the subject.

I am concerned about the impact on the local way of life that this proposal brings for a number of reasons. It appears that there are real concerns on the environmental impact of this proposal and these will affect all of us in the local community.

We use tank water on our property for everyday living for our family, our vegetable crops and our animals. I am concerned about the quality of water with increased pollution from the constant activity of trucks both during the construction and operation of the proposed site, as well as the dust, odour and contaminants that may travel through the air. The e contaminants will settle on the roofs that we collect water from and then be transfer ed to all aspects of our usage. We have no access to any other source of water except rainfall.

My understanding is that the application itself acknowledges that the landfill is at the headwaters of the Otokia stream and that wetlands will be drained. This is something which I understand would now be prohibited under the National Environmental Standards for Freshwater and this has really raised fears in the community. There have been many replanting exercises along Otokia Creek and the local community has taken a great pride in returning this body of water to be a healthy habitat for native eel, fish and plant-life. If the landfill is able to take hazardous substances, waste chemicals, asbestos and hospital waste there is a huge risk of a number of unwelcome contaminants getting into the creek.

In addition to this many in our community spend a lot of family time on the beaches and in and around the creek and I will certainly not feel as safe as I have, should the proposed activity go ahead. This is a beautiful part of the city that many come to as a retreat from daily life in the centre and they are welcomed by locals. A lot of our social activity as a community is at risk should this proposal go ahead – locals walks, horseriding, sustainable lifestyle farming – and this in turn would threaten the beautiful way of life we have collectively created and treasure.

I am concerned about the impact on the surrounding flora and fauna, should this proposal go ahead. Animals will change their behaviors, and some will be at greater risk - for example there will be a risk to the native NZ Falcons often seen in the area where the proposed site is, with a potential for upsetting their current living and breeding habitats, food sources (where the potential for easy scavenging from the waste may see them endangered rather than protected as they are). There will be more scavenger animals in the area, rodents, seagulls, pigs and the increased populations will also affect the balance of wildlife in the
