Parties

- 1. Ngā Rūnanga admit paragraphs 1 and 2.
- Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu is the statutorily recognised representative tribal body of Ngāi Tahu whānui (as provided by section 15 of the Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu Act 1996 (**TRONT Act**)) and was established as a body corporate on 24 April 1996 under section 6 of the TRONT Act.
- 3. Te Rūnanga o Moeraki, Kāti Huirapa Rūnaka ki Puketeraki, Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou and Hokonui Rūnanga (Kāi Tahu ki Otago) are four of the 18 Papatipu Rūnanga of Ngāi Tahu Whānui that are statutorily recognised under the TRONT Act and are mana whenua within the Otago region.
- The Plaintiff notified the Proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement (PORPS) on 26 June 2021. Kāi Tahu ki Otago and Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu made submissions on the PORPS.
- In response to the Plaintiff's Statement of Claim dated 3 September 2021, Ngā Rūnanga filed a Notice of Appearance on 26 October 2021.
- 6. On 20 December 2021 the High Court Registrar, by consent, made directions allowing Ngā Rūnanga to file a Statement of Defence by 22 December 2021.

Facts upon which the application is based

- 7. In relation to the allegations in paragraph 3, Ngā Runanga:
 - a. Admits paragraph 3(a); and
 - b. Denies paragraph 3(b) to the extent that the Plaintiff's functions in respect of the preparation of the PORPS are contained in sections 59 to 62 of the Resource Management Act 1991, but do not extend to section 63.
- 8. They admit paragraphs 4 to 8.

The Proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement 2021

9. They admit paragraphs 9 to 12.

Decision to subject whole of PORPS to freshwater planning process

10. They admit paragraphs 13 to 23.

Declaration Sought

11.Ngā Rūnanga are not required to plead in response to paragraph 24, which details the relief sought. However, Ngā Rūnanga record their support for the declarations sought by the Plaintiff in paragraphs 24(1), (2) and (4).
