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
How to use the Summary of Decisions Requested - Corrigendum (SODR – Part C)

The Summary of Decisions Requested by Submitters in relation to the *Proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement: Freshwater Planning Instrument* (FPI) has been amended by the addition or alteration of submission points previously transcribed incorrectly. This report updates, and should be read in conjunction with, the Summary of Decisions Requested (SODR) on the FPI. The SODR was notified on 21 January 2023. Further Submissions on Corrigendum

Further submissions are now invited on the submission points in the Corrigendum to the Summary of Decisions Requested only. **The closing date for further submissions to be received by ORC is 5.00pm on Wednesday 8 February 2023.**

A further submission must be limited to a matter in support of, or opposition to, a submission point in the Corrigendum to the Summary of Decisions Requested. A further submission must be in the form which is prescribed as Form 6 in Schedule 1 of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees and Procedures) Regulations 2003.
