May it please the Panel:

- The submitters are grateful for the caucusing direction contained in Minute 6. Although not identified in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the Minute, the submissions of OWRUG¹ and Federated Farmers² sought additional SRMR issue statements, variously acknowledging the importance of the food and fibre sector and the infrastructure that supports it to the Otago economy and in turn the wellbeing of people and communities (OWRUG), and the importance of access to natural resources to the people and communities of Otago (Federated Farmers). Dairy NZ further submitted in support of Fonterra's submission and OWRUG's submission.
