A. Introduction

 Beef + Lamb New Zealand Ltd (B+LNZ) and the Deer Industry New Zealand (DINZ) (collectively referred to forthwith as 'the submitters') welcome the opportunity to make a further submission on the proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement Freshwater Planning Instrument Parts (pORPS-FPI).

- 2. B+LNZ and DINZ could not gain an advantage in trade competition through this further submission.
- B+LNZ and DINZ are making this further submission because, as industry good organisations representing New Zealand's sheep and beef and deer famers. The submitters have an interest in this process which is greater than the general public interest.

The integrated management of land and freshwater addresses the interconnectedness of the ecosystems of these natural resources. The management of the use of these resources for the production of food and fibre is a priority for human health and for the social, economic and cultural well-being of people and communities. These are also the second and third priorities of Te Mana o te Wai (clause 1.3(5)) of the NPSFM. On a contextual interpretation of the pORPS, the provisions of the LF- Land and freshwater chapter must be aligned with the provisions of the IM-Integrated management chapter and should purport not override them. | That this submission be disallowed. | | | |
