MEMORANDUM OF COUNSEL FOR THE OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL

May it please the Commissioners:

Introduction

On 24 August 2023, the Supreme Court gave its decision in the Port Otago
 Limited v Environmental Defence Society and Others litigation¹. A copy of
 the decision is attached.

Outcome

- 2. Port Otago Limited's appeal was successful. The decision of the Court of Appeal is set aside.
- 3. The Regional Council is directed to consult the parties and any other persons it considers appropriate on a redrafted policy 4.3.7(d)-(e) for the partially operative Regional Policy Statement 2019.
- 4. The formal Order provides that the policy is either along the lines set out in paragraph [87] of the Supreme Court's judgment or to similar effect, or otherwise gives appropriate effect to the policies of the NZCPS and their inter-relationships.

What now?

- 5. The Regional Council will proceed as directed.
- 6. The decision is directly concerned with the policy provision for ports operated by Port Otago Limited in the Otago harbour in the partially operative Regional Policy Statement 2019.
- 7. The Court's decision is also directly applicable to provision for ports in the proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement 2021.
- 8. Otago Regional Council proposes to report to the Panel on the outcome of the port provision by Friday 22 September 2023.
- 9. It is possible that some parties see the judgment as having wider implications than simply setting the policy for the ports.

- 11. It is suggested the following timetable be adopted:
 - 1. Submitters to make submissions by 15 September 2023;
 - 2. Otago Regional Council to reply by 29 September 2023.
