We support the application as per all comments made but also due to the proposed building footprint does not exceed the current containers on the site at present but rather will dramatically improve the appearance. The proposed design of the dwelling has been thoughtfully considerate to the



appearance of a traditional boat shed and the colours proposed are that of muted tones and a palette that will blend into the surroundings. After reading the submissions from both the landscape architect and the ORC summary that the proposed building environmental look and feel has an overall minor to less than minor risk.

As the dwelling may offer limited accommodation which contains its own waste/grey water which would be removed/serviced by employed locals and employ local cleaners for the Air BnB it is also offering support to the community in other ways.

It would be nice to see this area revitalised as we as a family use the area for water activities and fishing and it would be of comfort to know that if ever the unfortunate circumstance arrived that we required assistance from an emergency service it would be comforting to know that facility of the floating pontoon with ramp and crane was available.

If the application is subject to limited notification, the consent authority may adopt an earlier closing date for submissions once the consent authority receives responses from all affected persons.

You must serve a copy of your submission on the applicant as soon as is reasonably practicable after you have served your submission on the consent authority.

Privacy: Please note that submissions are public. Your name and submission will be included in papers that are available to the media and the public, including publication on the Council website. Your submission will only be used for the purpose of the notified resource consent process
