

REGIONAL PLAN: WATER FOR OTAGO

Operative Date of Plan Changes 4B (Groundwater allocation) and 4C (Groundwater management: Cromwell Terrace Aquifer)

The Otago Regional Council has approved Plan Change 4B (Groundwater allocation) and Plan Change 4C (Groundwater management: Cromwell Terrace Aquifer) and resolved to make the changes operative from 1 September 2015.

Plan Change 4B clarifies and strengthens the provisions of the operative Water Plan for managing groundwater and avoiding over-allocation in Otago's aquifers, without changing their intent.

Plan Change 4C sets a maximum allocation limit of 4 Mm³/yr for the Cromwell Terrace Aquifer in Schedule 4A of the Water Plan.
