Summary of relevant part of Submission	Amend Plan Change 4C to detail aquifer restrictions for new consumptive groundwater takes and replacement consumptive groundwater takes from the Cromwell Terrace Aquifer as set out in recent resource consent decisions in the upper Clutha i.e. restrictions that provide a degree of protection to the resource consents providing for the operation of Lake Dunstan and Contact's hydroelectric operations. The submitter advised that they are likely to continue to submit on applications for groundwater that are hydraulically connected to surface water bodies, in particular the Clutha River, and on all applications within 100 m from a surface water body or that are beyond 100 m but deplete surface water by at least 5 l/s. This is because Council has suggested in correspondence that that these Clutha standard conditions are unlikely to be given recognition to the potential effects of allocating groundwater from the Cromwell Terrace Aquifer on the
