## ADDENDUM TO SUBMISSION

Not only as a ratepayer but as a concerned citizen of New Zealand I am very disturbed by the wanton destruction and money being spent on the so called Wilding Pines/Conifers in the Central Otago Area. There are three components to my annoyance with destroying the so called Wilding Pines issue.

### Preamble

The three issues I have with destroying wilding pines and conifers is based on environmental economic and aesthetics.

Additional I am very disturbed that there is no mention of the so called wilding pines issue in the *Draft Annual Plan - Your Feedback Please*. Why is this?

I hasten to add I am not a *Tree Hugger* but a pragmatist with an eye for forested hills/mountains.

### My concerns based on my assessment

[1] Environmental Concerns:- I believe it is criminal to destroy the natural reforestation of barren land. Barren land that has up till now been unproductive for any other agrarian purpose. Barren land that has been subject to erosion and does not have the ability to retain moisture as a reservoir. The world is suffering from de-forestation, and with changing weather patterns it is even more important to reforest or maintain forested land. Trees are essential for our environment and air quality and to destroy them appears to show a level of naivety and arrogance in believing that barren hills are so called better than forested ones. I firmly believe this council has been deceived by a fad into believing the only solution to wilding pines is total destruction.

I would like to use the hard hitting analogy that destroying Pines is similar to what happened during Second World War. A whole race of people were subject to extermination because of one mad man's whim. If you are bright you will be able to grasp the analogy. This council claims to be concerned about water quality and the degradation of the environment and in particular

the environmental damage caused by the dairy industry. And one of the options to assist with improving water quality is planting trees on both sides of water ways

The whole of Central Otago was forested until man with the aid of fire destroyed through pig ignorance and without any thought for the future

Throughout central Otago the landscape is covered in orchards, vineyards and small strands of pines. I do not hear a cacophony of complaints that growing fruit trees, having vineyards and having strands of tree is not environmentally friendly.

I am very concerned the ORC has in my opinion abdicated its responsibility in maintaining good water quality. The fact that our Central Otago Lakes are suffering from algae weed parasites etc., relates back to poor management of catchments which need forestation to assist with improving lake water quality. Hence we need the pines to provide the environmental filtration process

[2] Economic Concerns: - I firmly believe it is a criminal waste of money in destroying these pines, and wish to add that if this collective amount of ratepayers money was councillors own I am sure you would be very hesitant to spend it on such a frivolous venture just because a minority think it is nice (fad), to see barren hills

I note from the Annual Draft Plan the ORC wishes to spend money on some very worthwhile projects/causes. This being the case some of those causes/projects are deserving of extra money that could come from the waste of money on destroying this natural re-forestation.

In New Zealand we have vast areas on Pines/Conifers which are commercially harvested. I do not see people complaining about all these forested grow on hills/mountains. What a double standard. Wilding pines and other conifers may not at present be commercially harvested however it is only time before these pines become a commercial asset. However after having said this there is a small company operating in Central Otago extracting pine oil from wilding pines and conifers.

*Aesthetic Concern:-* I would argue that forested hills/mountains are far more pleasing than barren hills. I do not know any other country in the world who has embarked on wilful destruction of wilding pines/conifers such as New Zealand [a country without wisdom].

The only reason unsightly tussock is growing on the barren hills that once were forested is because they were unwisely destroyed. People were not concerned about the aesthetics of barren hills then.

Reiterating from my submission under the heading *Environmental Concern*, I have not witnessed one concern over the landscape beauty of orchards' and vineyards' in Central Otago. Fashion fads come and go however forested landscapes should be treasured forever.
