Apols for being a few hours late with this. I got home to Oturehua late (7 pm) after being at a meeting in Alexandra re water and other issues until nearly 6pm.

Submission/Response from Brian Turner (Chairman/President COES) to ORC's call for submissions related to the Manuherikia Integrated Water Management & ORC feedback session Summary of Values reports March 2017; also the call for submissions on the ORC's annual plan.

Firstly, I wish to advise that in my capacity as Chairman/President of the Central Otago Environmental Society I asked members of our committee to, if possible, lodge individual submissions on their own behalf. Why? In part because of the short time available in which to put together a response from the group as a whole, and because I felt that a few individual submissions would ensure we provided a more comprehensive overview of where COES stands.

I'm confident that the majority of our committee would be in accord with much of what I have to say here. (In this regard I wholeheartedly support the views expressed by, for instance, Matthew Sole and Jillian Sullivan, both members of the COES committee.)

Scientists everywhere remind us that all systems have their limits but, alas, in New Zealand, and elsewhere, many of our politicians and members of the public appear to believe there are no limits to 'growth', and refuse – or see ourselves as unable - to stop acting in ways that continue to result in degrading the natural environment.

In Central Otago the Manuherikia and our rivers and streams generally are greatly valued recreationally (for fishing, hunting, swimming, picnicking and so on) and ecologically - when they are allowed to maintain their natural values, their inherent diversity. But the Manuherikia and other waterways throughout the region suffer from overallocation resulting in dewatering in many reaches.

In some parts there's more algae and silt than there ought to be, used to be. This is not 'progress', quite the opposite. I put it to you that a lot of what is termed 'progress' and 'development' has, when related to our natural environment, resulted, and continues to result, in one or other of three words beginning with 'd': degradation, destruction, or depletion.

Minimum flows at Ophir and elsewhere - below Galloway for example - are insufficient whichever way they're looked at. This is an unpalatable truth.

In all sorts of ways our lands and waters continue to be put under the sorts of pressures that

are unsustainable if natural values and recreational opportunities are to be protected and, in some cases, enhanced. As Ronald Wright said in his 2002/3 Massey Lectures, called – perhaps ironically – A Short History of Progress,

'If civilization is to survive, it must live on the interest, not the capital, of nature. Ecological markers suggest that in the early 1960s, humans were using about 70% of nature's yearly output;' ... ' and in 1999, we were at 125%'. He added that such figures 'mark the road to hankruptcy.' I quake to think of where we're at now.

Margaret Atwood put it succinctly in her book *Payback*, saying that, worldwide, 'Nature is calling in her debt'. That reminded me of Paul Kingsworth's view that 'most of us' including 'much of the mainstream environmental movement are still wedded to a vision of the future as an upgraded version of the present.'

In our society we've got to the point where a high percentage of us see land and water as commodities belonging to us rather than – as Aldo Leopold put it – 'a community to which we belong.' He went on to say that 'A thing is right when it tends to preserve the integrity, stability and beauty of the biotic community. It is wrong when it tends otherwise.'

I was born in Dunedin in 1944. Since then I've lived in Otago for 65 of those years. After time spent working in Christchinch, then Wellington, in the 1960s and early 70s, I chose to return to the south because I saw Otago as my 'homeplace'. Hence my membership of many groups and organisations that focused on environmental issues, among them Forest and Bird, Save Manapouri, Save Aramoana, Friends of the Clutha, the Otago Fish and Game Council, and the Wise Response organisation.

One of the assertions often heard, and intended as a swipe at those who express concerns ahout activities that are environmentally damaging, is that the 'activists' are 'against progress', or 'development', and that they are seeking to prevent people exercising their 'rights'. When such allegations are made I often remember my father who frequently felt it necessary to remind his sons that, yes, of course we had rights but it was important to remember that we also needed to have regard for our duties and/or responsibilities.

One regularly hears it alleged that 'environmentalists' are 'anti-farming', business, so-called 'progress', and so on and on. For the most part that is untrue. The greatly respected American farmer and writer Wendell Berry said that 'all good farmers are conservationists, and all farmers ought to be.' To which I'd say, 'and most every one of us, whatever we work at, should try to be'.

In my case I have considerable respect for many farmers, admire their work ethic and their land management and knowledge. One of the many untruths directed at so-called 'Greenies' is that they are anti-business in general and farming in particular. Without farming, builders, mechanics, and... the list goes on and on, we would be bereft.

My parents, bless them, began to take us to various rivers and streams and forested as well as high country lands of the south, when my brothers and I were young boys. Our waterways were, for the most part, healthier, in hetter condition then than they are now. A lot of what's occurred, and in some parts continues, was and is termed 'progress' or 'development'. Fish and trees and water, for instance, are seen as 'resources', in other words items there to be bought and sold like 'commodities'.

When we look at the lands and forests and waters and oceans we ought to be saying, in

respect to a whole lot of things, 'let's try to do no harm'. But in order for that to occur we have to know, often, a lot more than we do about what's there, and what our actions may bring about. What about adopting the 'Precautionary principle', taking a more precautionary approach all round? Are we sure we know enough about what lives and grows in our places, what their needs are, and what effects our actions have had and continue to have?

Given New Zealand's climate, its location in the world, the size of its population relative to its land area, we ought to be able to look after our lands and waters and people and other species properly, better than we have been doing. But we're stubbornly continuing to fall short in those regards. It would be well to remember – I can't recall who said it – 'we don't inherit the world from our parents, we borrow it from our children'. And, to reflect on the truth in this: 'Nature bats last.'





West Harbour Recreation Trail Project:

As I am sure you and members of your Board will be aware, members of the Rotary Club of Dunedin embarked on a project with the aim of enhancing the edges of the Cycle/Walking Trail between the Dunedin Boat Harbour at the southern end and Maia at its northern end.

The project was commenced in January 2013 with the commencement of planning and budgeting. Planning approval was received from the DCC in October, 2013. The DCC has agreed to accept maintenance responsibility for the works as each stage is completed.

The budget came to approx. \$200,000 for all the products, trees and shrubs, signage and exercise equipment that is included in the project. This sum included the club's contribution of some \$12,000.

The design work is being carried out by Mr Mick Field--Landscape Architect--who did the original concept for the City Council, but who now works as a volunteer as part of the Rotary effort.

The labour for the project is largely by Rotarian volunteers, their friends and families and community groups coordinated by Rotary. To date it is estimated in excess of 800 hours of volunteer work has gone into development work, refinement of design, negotiations with the DCC staff and the physical work to beautify the edges of the Trail.

The project has attracted significant funding from the William Sherriff Charitable Trust, a grant from the Chalmers Community Board, Guardian Perpetual Trust Ltd and financial support from Ravensdown Fertiliser Co. The Otago Community Trust is also a major financial supporter and is covering the majority of the cost of the thirteen items of exercise equipment, three of which are already installed.

There is however, just one major funding requirement and that is for the double burner BBQ of a type designed for public use in a picnic environment and this is the reason for this letter to the ORC. This letter is a formal request for the funds necessary to finance the purchase of the stainless steel gas BBQ. The the model selected is BWB-G-2/2GBD and the cost is quoted at \$12,818, inc of GST.

The concrete pad and housing shelter for the BBQ is to be constructed by J G Gardner & Co at no cost to the project.

To you Sir and to ORC Board Members, the Project Group of the Rotary Club of Dunedin formally requests your assistance to fund this vital and socially interesting item within the project. We will be pleased to meet with you to discuss this if required.

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
