We have been representing local commercial fishermen in Otago for 108 years and our members contribute in excess of \$20 million per annum to the local economy. We have a good working relationship with Port Otago with good lines of communication however, we are concerned with the gradual deterioration of the wharf facilities, at the Careys Bays Wharf Complex. This complex is essential to our local commercial fishing industry.

Our Society owns a building on leased land and our Members lease wharf berths individually. In both Timaru and Bluff the facilities are being lost due to lack of continual maintenance and the closing of wharf area, the impact of this is devastating to our industry.

We believe that with the support of all the involved parties such as, commercial and recreational fishers, Port Otago and the Regional Council we can future proof this valuable facility for future generations.

Our main priorities are, maintain wharf piles at an increased rate, dredge berths, slipways and extend the dredging to Cays Bay recreational pontoon. Also to reinstate Rocky Point pile and swing moorings to offer an alternative to recreational vessels.

We currently have four people illegally living on vessels at the Careys Bay wharf complex which we feel is a Health and Safety concern. We have many layers of sub leasing of berths. In some cases lease holders not even living in Otago are sub leasing to local boats. It is our understanding the berth leases prohibit sub leasing however, this has never been enforced.

The Careys Bay wharf complex is and has always been a major asset and with prompt action will continue to be so.

The Port Chalmers Fishermen's Society has previously encouraged Port Otago to increase the commercial berth rate from \$800 to \$3,000 per year. A similar increase in recreational berths would increase income for this maintenance.

We would like to be involved with any discussion or decisions you may have and look forward to your reply.

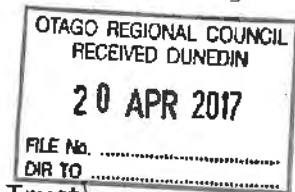

A changing policy landscape for environment and biodiversity restoration

- The battle to protect native species is now moving to landscape-scale control of predators and restoration of appropriate habitat. Central government's Predator Free New Zealand campaign is challenging the entire conservation community to lift their ambitions to eliminate the most dangerous predators by 2050.
- It is also increasingly obvious that central government does not expect to assume primary responsibility for resourcing the work that will have to be done.
- Instead it is increasingly obvious that community groups of unpaid volunteers and concerned citizens will be needed to provide the bulk of the resources (both human and financial) needed (estimated at over \$7 billion).
- To create and sustain a high level of community commitment to the Predator Free goal, there will be an ongoing need to educate and advocate for biodiversity restoration and build commitment to it in the public consciousness

Why ORC must take a leadership role in environment and biodiversity restoration

Too many players

- The scale of the Predator Free challenge will require the active involvement of multiple community groups, territorial authorities, and individual land owners.
- The rising number of community groups committed to the restoration of native species is good news for meeting the challenge
- However, concerted action across this diverse assembly of contributors requires leadership at the regional level.
- Relative to territorial authorities and community groups, the ORC is the institution that can engage with this challenge at the appropriate scale

Many kinds of intervention required

- A biodiversity strategy for the region requires coordinated action on multiple fronts: predator control; enhancement and extension of appropriate habitat (plantings in halos and corridors); re-introduction of species; education; training of volunteers.
- Community groups, territorial authorities and individuals can only be expected to focus their efforts on a sub-set of these.

- Coordination of effort again requires leadership at the regional level.

ORC's legal responsibility

- Responsibility for the environment is primarily vested in regional councils. The ORC has a clear responsibility to protect the environment.
- This includes taking a strong role in protecting and restoring New Zealand's gradually eroding indigenous biodiversity.

National strategies will not be enough

- Otago is proud of the region's distinctive biodiversity, among which are species unique to the region.
- The Predator Free NZ campaign is aimed only at a limited number of land based predators. Other causes of biodiversity loss must also be addressed through habitat restoration and planting, corridors, halos, translocations, advocacy, support for community initiatives.
- Biodiversity loss of aquatic species must also be addressed
- Central government is clearly not going to assume primary responsibility for resourcing the work that will have to be done.
- DOC is also showing a willingness to withdraw funding from established biodiversity projects such as Orokonui and the Yellow Eyed Penguin Trust.

Building on ORC's established commitment to biodiversity

- The ORC is now developing a regional biodiversity strategy, beginning with a stocktake of community actions and ambitions to restore biodiversity.
- The ORC's principle vehicle for biodiversity restoration is the Environment Enhancement Fund, currently disbursing around \$200,000 pa.
- It is good news that the ORC has expanded this fund over recent years.
- However sustained declines in biodiversity in New Zealand suggest that the ORC, like other regional councils, will have to do more if these declines are to be halted and reversed.
- The scope of work required suggests that the Environment Enhancement Fund will need to be made available for non-capital grants also
- A regional biodiversity strategy will help develop criteria for the use of these funds.

How to resource what must be done

- The engagement of community groups will be essential. Experience at Orokonui is that a dollar invested by a public body (DOC) has been multiplied 9 times from funds raised in the community, voluntary work, and other revenue sources. Only by engaging these groups will sufficient resources be applied to meet the challenge
- Currently Orokonui (1) attracts 20,000 visitors pa; (2) 6000 of which are school children in education programmes; (3) and 13,000 hours of volunteer time and training pa
- Environment Waikato has shown leadership in raising a specific rate of \$5.80 per household for heritage biodiversity. This generates over \$1million pa to be distributed "to provide seed or collaborative funding for community-based projects that (1) improve the environment (2) raise environmental awareness (3) use the enthusiasm and skills of the community (4) are consistent with the Council's statutory roles and community outcomes".

- The current budget for ORC's Environment Enhancement Fund is equivalent to approximately \$2 per household. Raising this to Waikato's level of \$5 per household would increase the fund to \$500,000 pa (half the Waikato level) to meet the growing challenge of biodiversity loss.

A uniform annual charge of \$5 per household will give public profile to ORC ratepayers that the Council is fulfilling its responsibilities to reverse the decline in our taonga, and is leading the region's efforts to make New Zealand safe again for life forms that exist nowhere else on earth, restoring a distinctive ecology that is part of our national culture and identity.
