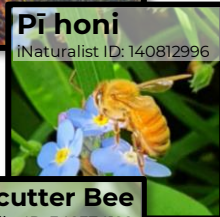

Pī o Aotearoa

Pi whakaurua

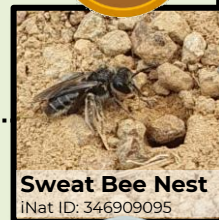
Ground Nesting Bees
