## Submission on proposed variations to the Otago Southland Regional Land Transport Plan 2015 – 2021

I would like to make a submission to the Regional Land Transport plan

I am specifically concerned with the state of the Dublin Bay Road off State highway 6 Wanaka to Hawea.

The road has significant use over the summer months with people accessing Dublin Bay reserve and beaches causing major corrugation issues.

The majority of the road is sealed however a small section of the road from state highway 6 remains unsealed. This has effectively created an issue with people unfamiliar with the road where it transitions from seal to the gravel.

I am a resident in the bay and have had to extract two vehicles from the water table after they have left the road. I have been approached a number of times by people fishtailing in the corrugations.

Unfortunately the current state of the unsealed part of the road means we will inevitably have a significant injury accident. (What particularly concerns me is the hazard to cyclists, walkers and horses who also use the road margins)
