Otago Regional Council (ORC) appreciates the opportunity to provide feedback on the draft plan.

We are pleased to support the overall direction and intent of the plan and look forward to further productive collaboration with the Queenstown Lakes District Council (QLDC) through the Otago Climate Officers Group, and the Otago Biodiversity Forum, as well as collaboration on implementation.
