

# PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLAN CHANGE 6AA

The Otago Regional Council has prepared Proposed Plan Change 6AA to the Regional Plan: Water for Otago.

**The plan change proposes to postpone the date at which conditions on discharge contaminant concentration and on nitrogen leaching come into force, from 1 April 2020 to 1 April 2026.**

This proposed plan change will have legal effect from 5 October 2019 in accordance with section 86B(3) of the Resource Management Act 1991.

- You may speak in support of your submission at a hearing;
- The Council gives notice of its decision on the proposal, including its reasons for accepting or rejecting any submissions; and
- Every person making a submission has the right of appeal to the Environment Court.
