Just in response to your queries:

- I agree we need to apply for a defence against water in terms of Rule 14.3.2.1.
- In terms of the discharge provisions we can comply with 12.C.1.1 in constructing the temporary working platform (would be clean rock not gravel with fines).
- Consent is required under Rule 12.3.4.1(i) for the temporary diversion of water as permitted activity rule 12.3.2.3(b) cannot be complied with as the diversion is in excess of one month.
- As discussed the vegetation removal required is covered by the general bed disturbance rule 13.5.3.1 which we already require consent under.
