

Total Mobility and COVID-19

Information Sheet for Total Mobility Card Holders in Otago

On 14 April 2020, Total Mobility was made fare-free for eligible users up to our regional subsidy cap of \$50. This will continue to be available until June 30 2020.

As a client, there is no change to your experience - you will still swipe your Total Mobility card at the start of each trip like normal. You won't be charged a fare at the end of the trip unless the fare has gone over the subsidy cap of \$50, in which case you will need to pay the driver the balance.

For Example: If the fare was \$60, \$50 of that will be covered by ORC & NZTA and the remaining \$10 would need to be settled with the driver.

- You must show the driver your Total Mobility card at the start of your trip
- Individual health and safety policies for each taxi / private hire company must be complied with
