Rights to Use and Maintain a Water Race

Under the Resource Management Act 1991, rights to use and maintain a water race are not able to be replaced with a permit. However, if the water race is not contained within your own property, you may wish to make application for a Section 417 certificate which can then be registered, similar to an easement, against the title of all lands involved; otherwise the right to use and maintain the race will expire on 1 October 2021.

There is an application deposit fee of \$500 incl GST for this.
