

If a Coastal Permit has been granted for a structure in the Coastal Marine Area, one of the consent conditions requires a consent plaque to be displayed. This plaque shows the consent number associated with the structure.

Please note that the plaque is not supplied as part of the consent process and must be ordered separately by the consent holder.

How to Order Your Consent Plaque

1. Request an ORC Consent Plaque
2. In your email, advise ProSigns that you require an ORC Consent Plaque.
ProSigns has the approved plaque template on file.
 - You will need to provide your consent number exactly as it appears on your consent document. For example: RM26.999.01
3. Arrange payment and delivery
 - The cost of the plaque is the responsibility of the consent holder and is not included in the processing costs of your consent.
 - ProSigns will advise payment options and can arrange courier delivery if required.
4. Install the plaque
 - Once received, the plaque must be displayed in accordance with the consent condition requirements.
