

Message to forestry block owners from Otago Regional Council

With recent severe weather, forestry blocks across Otago were impacted — with many trees damaged or brought down.

Environmental rules and good management practices still apply. If compliance with these practices is temporarily not possible due to damage or safety concerns, contact ORC without delay to discuss your situation.

Notification rules

- Harvesting activities require 20 working days notice to your local councils. However, salvaging only requires 2 working days prior to commencing works under the National Environmental Standards for Commercial Forestry (NES-CF). Please contact us to discuss these requirements further if you have concerns or the timeframes are impractical.
- Clean up and salvaging is likely to be ongoing. Please ensure the notification timeframe is incorporated in the works' planning.

Windthrow removal

 Some clearing and salvaging activities within waterways may be covered by Permitted Activity rule 13.5.1.2 of the Regional Plan Water. This rule allows for in-stream work following a storm event provided certain conditions are

- met, including duration (10 hours) and minimising disturbance. This rule as well as others can be found online Regional Plan:
