## New Zealand native

A small yet noisy forest bird with grey, buff and brown plumage. Flocks rarely come down from the canopy, where they hunt for invertebrates and give a mix of musical and chattering calls. Primary host species for the parasitic long-tailed cuckoo across Te Waipounamu / South Island.
